Congratulations to Oliver, Benji and Alice for placing in their respective age groups.











Thank you to all who attended the P&C meeting on Wednesday. Many topics were discussed including the setting of the voluntary school contribution, new sports shirt and Centenary plans. If you would like a copy of the minutes please email the school.

The P&C will be conducting a fundraising raffle for the school in conjunction with the Centenary. One of the prizes will be a food hamper. All families are asked to consider donating non-perishable food items towards the hamper prize. More information about the raffle and tickets will be sent home in the near future.

The voluntary school contribution amount has not been increased for many years.
